MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

You may renew your membership starting <u>April 1, 2023</u>. Please, renew by <u>JUNE 30</u> to avoid a \$25 late fee. If you renew after JULY 31, your membership is subject to availability. First, fill out the Membership Renewal Form on the web site and submit it, before mailing or coming to a meeting to pay your dues. JOAD practices are held Sundays from 4:30pm – 8pm on the Indoor Range from October thru April. Children ages 6-20 years are welcome. *Open to the public.* Child just has to become a junior member for \$10.00 per year. Equipment is available for children wanting to try archery & to confirm interest prior to investing in equipment. We provide USAA Level II Certified coaches. Competitions at other clubs begin in December and run thru April and would require joining USAA Association. (\$35) JOAD will host a tournament here at C.D.S.A. (dates for 2023 tournament to be advised) Parents are responsible for transportation to and from all tournaments. JUNIOR RIFLE (Indoor Range. Watch CDSA calendar for startup dates for 2022/2023 season.

Junior Rifle practice and shoots are held every Monday night from Oct to May, from 6 to 9 pm. This is for youth ages 11 to 18. Instruction will be given on gun safety, proper handling of a rifle and techniques. The shooters will be following the NRA 4-Position Stage Skill Rifle Qualification and they can earn medals and patches as they progress in their skills. They will learn to shoot effectively from prone, sitting, kneeling, and standing positions. The club provides the .22 rifles and ammo. Come to a meeting or stop by Monday night for info. *Open to the public*. Child just has to become a junior member for \$10.00 per year.
