Membership Update

Membership Dues increased for the **2024/2025 Membership** Year due to increasing costs. The new rates are as follows: Adult/Family \$100, Senior \$50, and Junior \$10. You can pay by cash, check, or credit card (please add an additional \$6 processing fee for credit cards). You may renew your membership starting April 1, 2024. Please, renew by **JUNE 30,2024** to avoid a \$25 late fee. If you renew after JULY 31, your membership is subject to availability. First, print out the Membership Renewal Form on the web site. then fill it out and sign it before mailing or

coming to a meeting to pay your dues. If you are unable to print a copy of the renewal form, please email Michelle at Secretary@cdsa.biz or call the club to leave a message. ALL renewals must be completed, this includes the *Life* Members. Failure to submit a completed and signed renewal along with any dues payment (if required) will result in loss of membership and access to the facility. REMEMBER to include a self-addressed, stamped, business size envelope, so we can mail your rules and membership card back to you. For members convenience a drop box has been installed on the front door of the CDSA Social Hall. (It looks just like a mail slot) Starting April 1, we will be able to drop our renewal forms and payments in this box.

FIRST AID



This is a notification to inform members they are responsible for providing first aid supplies for themselves and their guests. CDSA does not provide First Aid Kits and is not liable for any injuries that occur on CDSA property. We have Emergency Response Plans placed with the sign-in books and above the phone in the Ready Room to provide you steps and important information if you need to call 911. Membership responsibility for providing first aid supplies is number 20 in the CDSA Administrative Rules you will receive when you renew your membership.

Life Membership Update

There are a few updates for the Life Membership. A member with a Life Membership must complete, sign and return a renewal application each year. This ensures CDSA has updated information for all members, including the Life members. Contact information such as a mailing address or email address is essential for CDSA to keep all members informed, and updated emergency contact information ensures we have accurate information on file if it is ever necessary for CDSA to contact your emergency contact on your behalf. We must receive your signature on the renewal for each Membership year stating you attest you are permitted by law to own and shoot a gun, and you understand you are responsible for providing first aid supplies for you and your guests.

30 Minute Rule



come attention that some members are confused about the 30 minute rule. This is to clarify Range Rule number 11 in the CDSA Administrative Rules. " Please share all ranges. Ranges may not be used for more than 30 minutes if someone is waiting to shoot different equipment or distance." The 30 minute time starts the when second member signs in and informs the first they have arrived, not when the first member signed in.

If the first member is shooting archery it is not possible for the second member to shoot a pistol at the same time. In that case the second member must wait the 30 minutes. then is in control of the range. After another 30 minutes, the first member can take control of the range again. Please be respectful of those who shoot different disciplines than you, especially when young members are present. Thank you, Tom Mance, CRSO

Junior Rifle practice and shoots are held every Monday night from Oct to May, from 6 to 9 pm. This program is for youth ages 11 to 18. The shooters will be following the NRA 4-Position Stage Skill Rifle Qualification and they can earn medals and patches as they progress in their skills. Reminders

- 1. NO alcohol is permitted on the property
- 2. Range Closures: Please check the website calendar and notices posted on the ranges.
- 3. Safety must be your first priority when using the ranges. Please, keep muzzles pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- 4. NEVER TOUCH FIREARMS WHEN ANYONE IS ON THE RANGE!
- 5. Do not put them in a case. Do not adjust the sights. Do not touch them. Stand back and wait for the range to be declared hot. When the range is hot, you may handle your firearm.
- 6. "If you or anyone in your group causes CDSA property damage or violates any CDSA rule, regulation, or bylaw you must report the incident immediately by calling the CDSA president at the number listed at the sign in booths or e-mail directors@cdsa.biz. This action will be favorable to your defense and may save you from expulsion as a member of CDSA.
- 7. The C.D.S.A.'s goal is for all shooters to have a SAFE and positive experience on all ranges.
